ENTRY ORDERING DEPOSIT OF FUNDS IN LIEU OF BOND

The guardian has applied to the court to deposit certain monies with _____
_____ in the name of the ward and the Probate Court of Licking County, in lieu
of posting bond to cover the guardian's liabilities for these funds.

The Court finds the application well taken and authorizes the guardian to deposit the funds set forth in the application on the reverse side with the above financial institution. Upon proper receipt by the financial institution, the guardian shall be denied access to the funds, both principal and interest by the financial institution without written authorization of the Court with the following exception:

The guardian may renew certificates of deposit, money market certificates, etc. as they become due and may transfer funds from one type of savings account to another within the financial institution to maximize the interest earned.

The guardian must file back with the court Verification and Receipt and Deposit within 30 days.
